03 | Why now (January 2026)

Geopolitical Pivot:


Following the Dec 21, 2025 announcement (widely reported Dec 22) of a U.S. Special Envoy to Greenland, institutional attention toward Greenland has intensified.

Official Framework:

Greenland's Mineral Resources Strategy 2025–2029 provides the governance frame; the Mineral Resources Authority's licence register signals dozens of active licences (30+).

Implication (interpretation):

Institutional communication is converging on a limited set of primary terms: critical minerals, rare earths, investment, energy, climate.



04 | Strategic Thesis (no hype)

Scarcity-driven asset:

A defensible cluster of primary category terms under Greenland's ccTLD (.gl).

Value Case:

Predominantly defensive (pre-emptive terminology control), not traffic-dependent.


Deployable Hub:

A neutral, source-led web layer that can be extended into an IR portal or policy library.
